Duties of the Attorney General

John Keller, Chief Deputy Attorney General and Dick Allyn, Former Deputy Attorney General, presented an overview of the duties of the Office of the Attorney General, the specific duties of the Attorney General and the compensation of the Minnesota Attorney General.

Council member Gail Olson presented data comparing Minnesota's constitutional officers' salaries with other states and data showing what the salaries of the constitutional officers would be if adjusted for inflation.
